SUN, MAR 13

LONDON

Welcome to England! Upon arrival, meet your local guide and begin your stay with a guided panoramic tour of London. See Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, Buckingham Palace, Piccadilly Circus, Tower Bridge, Trafalgar Square, Fleet Street, and St. Paul's Cathedral. The balance of the day is free for activities arranged by the tour leader.

MON, MAR 14

LONDON

On your guided walking tour of the city, watch the Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace, walk "The Mall" through St. James Park, see the famous 10 Downing Street and other highlights. Also, visit the renowned Westminster Abbey, and its Poet's Corner where over 100 poets and writers are buried or have memorials. Later, visit the British Museum, their remarkable collection spans over 2 millions years of human history and culture, see the Rosetta Stone, the Parthenon Sculptures and Egyptian Mummies. B

TUE, MAR 15

LONDON

Visit the Tower of London, a historic castle off the north bank of the River Thames. Experience this majestic piece of history that was founded during the Norman Conquest of England in 1066 (with an audio guide.) Visit the Charles Dickens Museum, housing the world's most comprehensive collection of material relating to the life and work of Charles Dickens. This afternoon, enjoy a traditional English tea. B

WED, MAR 16

LONDON

As part of an official Shakespeare's Globe Workshop, tour the Exhibition & Theater, a wonderful re-creation of the bard's original playhouse built in 1599 where there are no spotlights, microphones, speakers or amplification and all music is performed on live instruments. As part of the Workshop, spend one hour based on any Shakespeare play of your choice with one of the Practitioners. Tonight, attend a Globe Theatre Performance. B

THU, MAR 17

LONDON - EDINBURGH

Transfer to the train station and board your train to Edinburgh. It is here that Sir Walter Scott wrote his romances and Robert Burns met his beloved Clarinda. This is also the city of Robert Louis Stevenson and Sir Arthur Conan Doyle. Your private bus and driver will escort you on a half day guided Edinburgh City Tour. Visit Edinburgh Castle, a fortress



that sits atop the apex of a now extinct volcano! See St. Margaret's Chapel, the State Apartments, Great Hall and the Crown Chamber. B

FRI, MAR 18

EDINBURGH

Use your Hop On Hop Off passes to explore Edinburgh with your tour leader. Edinburgh has a rare charm with narrow and cobbled passageways, called closes in Scots. You may choose to visit the Writer's Museum, the National Museum or The Scottish Poet's Library. Be sure to climb Arthur's Seat for a spectacular view over the Firth of Forth. B

SAT, MAR 19

EDINBURGH

Continue exploring this fascinating city with your group. See the Miracle Mile, Edinburgh's most famous street, The 200-foot Gothic spire on Princes Street was built in honor of Sir Walter Scott. Stop at Carlton Hill for fantastic views of this memorable city. Experience Edinburgh's darker, more mysterious side on a spine-chilling Ghost Tour tonight. B

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home with many new memories of your adventures in England & Scotland! B
