Checked Baggage

International Travel

The U.S., Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands to, from or through Europe and India: Travelers may check one bag for no charge

The U.S., Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands to or from Central America: Travelers may check one bag for no charge

Size Per Piece Allowed: 62 in/157 cm (length+width+height)

Maximum Weight Per Piece: 50 lbs/23 kgs

Over 50 lbs/23 kgs but less than 70 lbs/32 kgs - is subject to an overweight baggage charge (Maximum of three excess pieces will be accepted.)

Carry on Baggage

You can carry on one bag plus one personal item per passenger as long as:

- They weigh no more than 40 lbs/18 kgs
- The bag is no more than 45 inches and the personal item is no more than 36 inches when you add the length + width + height so that it fits in an overhead bin or under the seat

Personal item - includes: backpack purse, briefcase, laptop OR a similar item such as book bag or tote that does not exceed 36 inches (length+width+height) and fits under the seat.

Additional items that will be allowed above and beyond the restrictions listed above include:

- Outerwear such as coats/wraps/hats
- · Book or newspaper

- Umbrella stroller for lap or ticketed child
- Diaper bag for lap or ticketed child
- Small bag of food to eat on the flight see guidelines for liquids
- Approved safety seat for lap or ticketed child
- Assistive devices for passengers such as wheelchairs, walkers and CPAP machines
- Therapeutic oxygen provided by the airline

Liquids/Gels/Aerosols

The following items may be transported in carry-on baggage only if in a 3.4-oz container or smaller and transported in a onequart clear, plastic, zip-top bag. Otherwise, these items must be packed in checked baggage.

- Toiletries shampoo, toothpaste, mouthwash, perfume, shaving foam, aerosols, deodorant, eye care products
- Cosmetic products perfume, hair spray/gel, lip gloss, mascara, nail polish, makeup removers/cleansers, foundation
- Non-solid food items soups, syrups, pressurized food containers (cheese or whipped cream), gelatin, pudding, yogurt
- · Liquid soaps, sanitizers, bath oils, bubble bath
- Any creams, ointments or lotions
- All other liquids/gels not listed here

To Simplify Your Security Screening:

- Place all liquid containers in a separate clear plastic, zip-top bag no larger than 8in x 8in (20cm x 20cm) or is quart size. Items must fit in the bag comfortably so that it closes completely.
- Individual liquid containers should be no larger than 3.4 ounces/100 ml.
- Remove the plastic bag from the cabin bag at the security checkpoint for separate x-ray screening

British Airways

Checked baggage

1st bag free (maximum weight 50 lbs & 62 linear inches)

Size:

a standard size bag must not exceed 90cm x 75cm x 43cm (35.5ins x 29.5ins x 16ins), including the handle, pockets and wheels.

a non-standard sized bag must not exceed 190cm x 75cm x 65cm (75ins x 29.5ins x 25.5ins), including the handle, pockets and wheels

Weight:

Overweight charges: Each bag over 23kgs (51lbs) and up to and including 32kgs (70lbs) will incur a charge of £65 (\$100 for journeys to and from all US airports) at the airport.

This fee will be converted into the local currency during the check-in process.

Carry on baggage

One standard-sized bag One laptop-sized bag, handbag or briefcase

The standard-sized bag is no more than 56cm x 45cm x 25cm (22ins x 18ins x 10ins), including the handle, pockets and wheels.

The bag must be able to be:

fitted into the gauge available in the check-in area

lifted into the aircraft's overhead lockers unaided

Restrictions on the quantities of liquids, gels or pastes are:

they must be held in individual containers not exceeding 90ml (3 US ounces)

the containers must be carried in a separate, clear-plastic, zip-top or re-sealable bag

the bag must not exceed 20cm x 20cm (8ins x 8ins) in dimensions

the bag must not exceed one litre (1.75 pints) capacity

the bag must be completely closed

the items must fit comfortably in the bag

the bag must be x-ray screened separately from other hand baggage at airport security points

before boarding, secondary searches may be performed if you are carrying liquids.

Duty-free goods containing liquids may be carried, provided they are purchased after the security screening point. We advise you to pack any duty-free liquids in your checked baggage where possible.
