Afterwards, take a ferry ride from Battery Park out to the Statue of Liberty, where you can photograph the amazing skyline before heading to Ellis Island to learn about the early settlers. The people of France gave the Statue, standing 151'1" from base to torch, to the people of the United States over 130 years ago in recognition of the friendship established during the American Revolution. Over the years, the Statue of Liberty has grown to include freedom and democracy as well as this international friendship. Your afternoon is free for exploration with your advisor. No visit to New York City would be complete without a shopping expedition. Why not explore the great stores that line Fifth Avenue, visit Bloomingdales, Tiffany's and Macy's.
